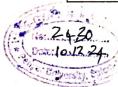

Suggestions: It is resolved to increase the number of LSCs by issuing a circular to all affiliated colleges, encouraging them to act as LSCs within the territorial jurisdiction to cater to the needs of that particular locality student's community. It is ALSO resolved to continue the existing tuition fee-sharing ratio 60:40, with 60% for the university and 40% for the LSCs. Agenda: Proposing new postgraduate programmes and diploma certificate programmes to be introduced in the academic year 2025-2026 (both in Tamil and English medium). Suggestions: Members discussed and approved the introduction of the following programmes: M.A. Tamil M.A. Economics M.A. History M.A. Sociology M.Sc. Applied Psychology Agenda: Deliberation on the effective scheduling management of Personal Contact Programmes (PCP) classes by programme coordinators. Suggestions: It is resolved that the Centre for Distance and Online Education (CDOE) shall prepare a schedule for PCP classes in alignment with UGC regulations for the adoption by the programme co-ordinators. Agenda: Strategies to improve student admission for the January 2025 calendar session. Suggestions: It is resolved to implement several strategies for publicizing admissions, including: Organizing press meets and engaging with press clubs.

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- Displaying flex banners on university buses and at collector offices within the territorial jurisdictions.
- Publishing flash news updates on the university website in the front page.
- Conducting meetings with LSC Coordinators of affiliated colleges for improving the admission.

Members emphasized the importance of a robust Student Support System to improve admissions. It is resolved that the system will provide efficient assistance during the admission process and ensure the timely issuance of certificates to students. A help centre exclusively for ODL students is to be setup. List out the pending items for those students who have not completed the course and address their issues.

Agenda: Initiatives to enhance placement support and opportunities for ODL and OL students by placement cell.

7. Suggestions: It is resolved to organize separate campus recruitment drives for ODL students to improve their placement opportunities along with Placement for regular students. Placement Support for ODL and OL Students with the Placement Coordinator of university should be ensured by regular correspondence.

Agenda: Discussion on enhancing Grievance Redressal Mechanisms

Suggestions: Members discussed the need for effective Grievance Redressal Mechanisms. It is resolved to develop a dedicated mobile application for addressing student grievances and create WhatsApp groups for the headquarters to share the academic information and relevant updates to the students.
